RHC Safety Course

Tim Tucker, who has been conducting the Robinson Factory Safety Course for 30 years, came to Sloane in July 2016 and 14 pilots attended the course.

The purpose of the overseas Robinson Factory Safety Course is to enhance the safety of pilots operating R22/R44/R66 helicopters outside the USA and is tailored to the local flying environment.

The course consisted of two days of ground study after which all students flew with Tim and experienced the Vuichard vortex ring recovery technique. Robinson Helicopter Company news

- Garmin GTX 335 and 345 Mode S transponders are now available as an option for the Robinson range of helicopters. These transponders meet the forthcoming EASA regulations at minimum cost.
- The optional auxiliary fuel tank for the Robinson R66 Turbine is now available and extends the helicopter's range by more than 200 nm.
- Following FAA certification of the two-seat R44 Cadet in May 2016, Robinson have delivered two R44 Cadets to an Australian customer and additional aircraft to Flying Schools in South Africa and USA.
- The Garmin G500H Avionics Display System is now available as an option on both the R44 Raven II and the R44 Cadet. The G500H is made up of Primary Flight Display (PFD) and Multifunction Display (MFD) units offering moving maps, instrumentation and situational awareness.
- A collective-activated hour meter with an updated hub and redesigned main rotor spindles has been introduced on all new Robinson R22s. The key advantage of the collective-activated hour meter is that it does not record engine warm up and cool down time.





BRDC Rising Star Patronage

Sloane has recently become a Patron of the British Racing Drivers' Club (BRDC) Rising Star Programme. The BRDC is the most exclusive club in motor racing and is both the owner and operator of Silverstone circuit.
