Technical Review of the Robinson Range of Helicopters

The technical review day will be conducted by Dick Sanford who is a Robinson Helicopter Company accident/technical investigator from Mornington Sanford Aviation and will include a review of recent accidents, human factors, critical flight conditions and a technical review of the Robinson helicopter range.

This is an ideal opportunity for pilots to improve their systems/cockpit interface and emergency procedures knowledge. A high percentage of accidents occur as a result of an overreaction to a benign indication in the cockpit. 'It's not what happens but it's how you react to what happens that determines the outcome.' Do you really know what you are supposed to be looking for during a pre-flight check?

Throughout the day you will have the opportunity to network with other pilots and flight instructors and share your flying experiences. The course will significantly benefit Robinson owners by providing you with the knowledge of how to look after your Robinson helicopter.

Robinson Adds a Range of New Features

Robinson has recently released a number of new R44 and R66 options, including the ones shown below. We will be pleased to discuss the benefits of these systems with you and advise you of the system that will best meet your requirements.

Garmin G500H TXi Displays

The Robinson Helicopter Company has now added the Garmin G500 TXi displays to the available options on the R44 and R66 helicopters. These touchscreen displays bring PFD/MFD information onto a single screen whilst interfacing with the Garmin GTN 6/7 series GPS.

The Garmin Display Units (GDU) available include the GDU 1060 TXi and the GDU 700L. The GDU 1060 TXi is a 10.6-inch display installed in the large G500 display with additional room for any Garmin GTN 6/7 GPS and a Genesys SAS/Autopilot.

The GDU 700L is a 7-inch display that is to be installed in Robinson's new compact console and spares room beneath for any Garmin GTN 6 series GPS. This display has been designed specifically for Robinson and enables pilots to switch between a full screen PFD and a full screen Moving Map therefore eliminating the needs for a separate GPS console in front of the pilot. We will be pleased to discuss the benefits of these systems with you further.



R66 Wire Strike Protection Provisions

Robinson has now added wire strike protection provisions as an available option on the R66. This provision allows easy installation of the Magellan wire strike protection system onto R66 helicopters.



R66 Cargo Hook

Robinson has created two different cargo hook installations for the R66. The Basic installation includes the cargo hook and right-seat controls, whereas the Advanced installation includes the cargo hook with both right and left seat controls

together with a left seat hydraulic switch and start button. The Advanced installation also provides a load weight and second set of engine power gauges located in the left door sill along with provisions for remote control of external equipment.
